Abstract: Half page, maximum 300 words

Introduction: Maximum 1½ page based on review of relevant and recent literatures

supporting contextual background, clear statement of research gaps

and significance of the study

Research Objectives: Two to three specific objectives

Rationale of the study: Half page

Study Area: Half Page; concise description and features of study sites relevant to

proposed study

Methodology: Maximum 2 pages, clear description of research design, data

collection methods and tools and statistical analysis

Timeframe: Six Months

Budget plan: Maximum NRs. 35000 (Thirty-five thousand)

References: APA format

Submission Format: MS word Format, Font: Time New Roman, Font size: 12

Line spacing: 1.5 point; Page margins: one inch (1") on all four sides

Thematic Areas:

The research proposal should be in any of the following thematic areas.

- Scientific forest management
- Nursery experiment
- Forest based enterprise and harvesting practices
- Watershed health assessment
- Wildlife diet, nutrition, and health
- Forest diseases
- Urban forest and tree management
